Scholte Church

Historical Village at 507 Franklin Street

The Historic Scholte Church, featuring beautiful woodwork, large windows, and a high ceiling, is the perfect location for dinners, small weddings, lectures, and more. The space includes access to a kitchenette located in the connected Viersen House - which also makes a lovely spot for more photos or a bridal suite.

Capacity: 64 people at tables, 100 chairs only



Scholte Garden Room

Scholte House at 728 Washington Street

The Scholte Garden Room located inside the Scholte House offers the perfect location for bridal showers, baby showers, birthday parties, meetings, and more! Included is a kitchen and bathroom for your guests' comfort, as well as a projector and screen.

Capacity: 48 people at 6 round tables



Maria's Tea Room

Scholte House at 728 Washington Street

Maria's Tea Room is also located in the historic 1848 Scholte House. Beautifully remodeled, the tea room can be reserved for a hosted tea party or rented for your own private gathering.

Capacity: 24 people at 7 tables

Scholte Gardens

Scholte House at 728 Washington Street

Scholte Gardens, bursting with tulips or summer flowers, is beautiful throughout the season. Celebrate a lovely garden wedding, host a tea party family reunion, schedule your group's yoga session, and so much more. (This is a public garden and cannot be closed to outside visitors.) Your rental includes use of the Scholte Garden Room Wing.

Capacity: Up to 200 people, depending on set-up



Historical Village

Historical Village at 507 Franklin Street

Surrounded by our 22 building complex, the lawn of our Historical Village is a wonderful place to host a large crowd, from weddings and receptions to corporate events, retirement parties, and more. Rental includes tables and chairs, and we love to showcase our museum buildings to your guests! Your rental includes the Village Bakery - a great space for food prep or cake cutting.

Capacity: 250-300 people



Village Bakery

Historical Village at 507 Franklin St.

Our Village Bakery is a wonderful spot for small gatherings, such as showers, gender reveal parties, or interactive classes. Refurbished as a working 1850s bakery, you'll find running water, electrical outlets, and a refrigerator for your use. The Bakery can be accessed through the alley for guest privacy and vendor ease.

Capacity: 20 people at 4 small tables

Sterrenberg Library

Historical Village at 507 Franklin St

The library is a cozy spot for meetings and intimate gatherings. It has a large antique table that seats 10, and more tables and chairs can be added. The walls are lined with books, inspiring an Old World academic feeling.

Capacity: 20-25 people



Wyatt Earp House

Historical Village at 507 Franklin Street

If you want to walk in the same footsteps of a famous Western lawman, this is the location for your next gathering! Wide open spaces and a modern exhibit all about Wyatt Earp will greet your guests at this restored, original 1800s home. Let wild West memorabilia serve as a backdrop to cocktail hour, receptions, and more.

Capacity: Up to 60 people



Amsterdam School

1010 198th Place

This nearly 150-year-old school house is a great spot for family reunions, outdoor picnics, and more. Located south of Pella, you have access to the one room school house where you can see how children of yesteryear learned their reading, writing, and 'rithmetic. There is no running water at this location, but a port-a-potty and water pump are available.

**Capacity: Up to 20 people indoors,
50-60 outdoors**
